The gross motor room is a fun environment for the people we serve to develop their gross motor skills i.e. balance, coordination, muscle strength, motor planning, etc.

The people we serve can slide on the slide, jump on the trampoline, swing on the swing, walk through an obstacle course, or play ball. Through the various gross motor activities they will not only develop body awareness, but release stress and anxiety and be provided with a sense of relief and achievement



Experiences with Gross Motor

K is an individual who seeks a lot of movement on a regular basis. During times of anxiety he will scream and bite his shirt. When placed on the swing or therapy ball he will immediately calm down, begin to smile and will be able to stay calm for longer periods of time following the gross motor activity.

N is an individual with poor body awareness. Due to that, he faces challenges in motor planning and coordination. In the gross motor room he is able to develop his skills and through the physical activity increase his body awareness. N skates on roller-skates, walks on the rocking board and jumps on the trampoline. N enjoys his time in the gross motor room and leaves with a sense of pride and achievement. As he walks down the hall to his homeroom he expresses his pride by saying to everyone who crosses his path "I did it! I did it!"

Multi-Sensory Room

The multi sensory room provides a variety of exciting sensory activities such as sand play, water play, ball pool and many other fun sensory activities. It offers the people we serve various leisure experiences which allow them to develop fine motor, cognitive and gross motor skills. In the multi-sensory room the people we serve are smiling, they are exploring the different activities at their own will and have a sense of relaxation and control.



Experiences within the Multi-Sensory Room

B is an individual that seeks a lot of touch and enjoys exploring different textures. He has challenges in settling down in one room and he constantly has the urge to pace around the building in order to regulate himself. In the Multi-Sensory Room B enjoys the sand play and is able to sit for long periods of time and play in the sand. When B is playing in the sand he is smiling broadly and is more responsive to communication with his therapist. For B, the Multi-Sensory Room is the one room he can settle down and exchange his restlessness and anxiety with pure fun.

Occupational Therapy Room

The Occupational Therapy room is a sensory environment that is set up by the Occupational Therapist for the purpose of individual therapy and group therapy.

It is important for the people we serve to have a safe environment where they can connect with their Occupational Therapist and work together to achieve their goals. The Occupational therapy scope of practice is to build a solid foundation using sensory integration approach in order for the people we serve to engage in meaningful occupations thus enhancing their quality of life.



When the therapy intervention and the environment are conducive to meet the individual's needs he/she can overcome their challenges and experience success.

Snoezelen Room

Snoezelen rooms were developed with the intention of providing people who have sensory and learning disabilities with appropriate relaxation facilities. At the base of the Snoezelen lies the belief that we all need stimulation. People with special needs have the right to appropriate stimulation that encourages the participation of the person we serve, therefore the development of special environment i.e. Snoezelen environment, is needed.

Above all, Snoezelen provides an environment for relaxation through gentle stimulation. The Snoezelen environment removes the pressure to achieve such that it enables the development of trust between therapist and the person we serve. Thus, the person we serve can grow and explore a multi stimulus environment at his or her own pace.



Snoezelen room experiences...

J is an individual who is normally very sensitive to touch. He tends to rock back and forth and avoids eye contact. When J enters the Snoezelen environment he is able for the first time to sit still and relax. He is able to touch the therapist's forehead with his own and look directly in her eyes. J is also able to tolerate touch for longer periods of time.

A is young woman who normally paces around the building and screams due to her high anxiety state. She displays self injurious behaviours such as scratching, banging her fists against the wall and biting herself. Due to her high anxiety state, she faces challenges engaging in the different activities offered in the centre. When A enters the Snoezelen environment her tone of voice is softer, her breathing is more even and her use of verbal communication is increased. A is able to engage in activities in the Snoezelen environment. She enjoys spreading shaving cream on the mirror, smelling different scents and exploring various objects.
